St. Mary's Sailing Club 60th Anniversary Invitational Regatta
June 13-14, 2015



Registration: On-site registration Friday June 12th 1800-2000 and Saturday June 13th, 0830-1000.

Sailor's Information Meeting: Saturday June 13th at 0900.

Sailing Information: Saturday events begin 1030 AM, with Sunday start scheduled for 1000. Events will be completed by ~1400 Sunday. St. Mary's Sailing Club is on the south shore of St. Mary's Reservoir, on a peninsula that provides quick access to a large open-water area. Courses will be sailed from a Start/Finish area within 1 km of the club. Windward-leeward and triangular courses, plus a "Round the Islands" option, will be described in the Sailing Instructions, to be provided at on-site registration.

Cost: \$60 single/\$80 double-handed boats. Lunches \$10 per day. Saturday Alberta Beef supper \$20.

Site & Accommodations: St. Mary's Sailing Club has a rustic clubhouse, concrete launch ramp and an additional hand-launching area. Rough camping is available at the club, off-grid with outhouses, and no running water. Many participants like onsite camping for evening views and fireside socializing. Want a roof over your head? Directions: St. Mary's Sailing Club is located at 49.3109779493N; 113.190216058W. From Highway 5 (the highway between Cardston and Lethbridge) turn northwards onto Range Road 244. This is at a point about half way between Cardston and the Village of Spring Coulee. Range Road 244 is a gravel road that becomes a two-track trail after about 3km, then continues for another 2km to it's end at St. Mary's Sailing Club.
