1 RULES

The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The event is open to all classes.
- 4.2 To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall have completed all registration requirements and paid all fees.
- **4.3** Boats will be scored using the current wind-adjusted Portsmouth handicapping system.

5 FEES

- 5.1 Register online at <u>Here</u>. Regatta includes the regatta, Friday night wine & cheese reception, and breakfasts Saturday & Sunday. The regatta fee is \$200 per boat and includes 4 Saturday Dinner tickets.
- 5.2 Early Entry Fee (prior to August 22):

7 VENUE

Racing will take place on the waters in close proximity to the Sylvan Lake Sailing Club on Sylvan Lake, Alberta.

8 COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be Windward/Leeward with a Hollywood Finish.

9 SCORING

- 9.1 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 9.2 (a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
 - (b) When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores, excluding her worst score.

10 RISK STATEMENT

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, DECISION TO RACE. The OA will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regattas.

11 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$2,000,000 per incident or the equivalent for the duration of the regattas. The organizing authority does not accept any responsibility for verifying that a boat has valid third-party liability insurance.
