4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

4.1 The event is open to all classes.

4.2 To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall have completed all registration requirements and paid all fees.

4.3 Boats of the same class registered by the 2nd of September at 0855 hrs may be scored as a fleet at the discretion of the Race Officer (RO). All other boats will be scored using the current wind adjusted Portsmouth handicapping system.

5 FEES

7 VENUE

Racing will take place on the waters at Camp Kuriakos on Sylvan Lake, Alberta.

8 COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be Windward/Leeward with a Hollywood Finish.

9 SCORING

10.1 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

- 10.2 (a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- (b) When from 5 to 10 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- (c) When more than 10 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

10 RISK STATEMENT

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, DECISION TO RACE. The OA will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regattas.

11 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$2,000,000 per incident or the equivalent for the duration of the regattas. The organizing authority does not accept any responsibility for verifying that a boat has valid third-party liability insurance.
