As you know Sail Canada and Alberta Sailing Association have been working hard to develop a comprehensive Safe Sport package for sailing at all levels in the country. Alberta Sailing is pleased to announce that we have adopted the complete Safe Sport Policy Package.

As we move forward with our work in Safe Sport, each member organization will be required to adopt and implement the Safe Sport Policies. To help support this process we are asking each organization to designate a Safe Sport Lead.

What does a Safe Sport Lead do and who should take on this role?

The person should:

- Be committed to the role for the next year (at least)
- Be committed to champion this initiative and passionate about Safe Sport
- Understand concepts of governance, legislation, policies and procedures
- Be comfortable leading discussions, training, and communication within the club
- Be able to be the “go-to” about what the policies include & how they work together
- Be able to lead organization to meet timelines and accomplish all tasks
- Be willing to become the liaison between your organization’s Board/Leadership and Alberta Sailing’s Safe Sport Lead Kathy Speck, and with other organization’s leads within the province for Safe Sport discussions.
