- o Ryan working on SC's strategic plan an 18-month plan with the goal being
- Stabilization
- Working on a Sail GP partnership with We/I Can Foil and hoping provinces can add it. A foiling instructor course has been set up – one to be held in May and one in June with pro wing foiler Max Robinson
- There is a CANSail foiling 1 & 2 instructor module ready and a working group forming for 3 & 4, and a plan for rolling out CANSail 2.0.(CANSail 1-4) Kathy has distributed SC's announcement about version 2.0 to clubs and schools. CANSail Keelboat possibly coming, set up the way the dingy program is. Updates to instructor pathways coming in 2026. SC is trying to roll out an Accessible Sailing PC module in 5 provinces, starting in May in Quebec.
- Survey results showed there is a desire for adult programs. More summaries will be out soon
- Sailing for All Grant was announced, and CYC and ASAA have been selected to receive funding
- Owen Bird is working on the SC database but no changes have taken effect yet
- Lisa Roddie announced many policy changes to Safe Sport for April 1 Kathy will contact her to find out what should now be on the website.
- The CSG committee is looking for stories and/or videos to feature teams and athletes. There will be no sailing streaming from the games.
